Elements of the program:

- To provide a learning environment that is particularly suited to the needs of the gifted child
- To provide enrichment opportunities and specific activities to students in the following areas:
 - a. Independent and Self Directed Studies
 - b. Higher Level and Critical Thinking Skills
 - c. Decision Making
 - d. Creative Problem Solving
 - e. Creative Expression
- To promote activities that incorporate multi-disciplinary approaches to instruction

Description of Services:

The program offers many different inclusive strategies to meet the needs of the identified students in the school. Four areas of focus are:

Exposure - offering students new and different learning opportunities

Extension - expanding the curriculum through independent studies

Development - designing the program to meet students' needs and interests

Acceleration - moving students at rates that is commensurate with their development
