1. Facilities/Maintenance:
    - a. New or significantly changed items appearing in the budget draft under Facilities include:
      - i. XL Automation Contract \$37,000.00
      - ii. Outside Cameras - Replace with HD, \$3,000.00
      - iii. Motors for Air intake (4@ 7,500.00), \$30,000.00
      - iv. Repairs to gym siding, \$45,000.00
      - v. Construction Project Oversight, \$5,000.00
    - b. Sign Update: Our sign is still not here.
  2. Staffing Changes:
    - a. Things seem to be working very well after the adjustments we recently made.
  3. Garden:
    - a. Angela Wheaton has agreed to become the garden coordinator over the summer.
    - b. We are planning to have Caroline Moore integrate gardening lessons into the curriculum as part of her duties next year. She and Angela will work out details with the Garden Committee in the coming months.
  4. Activities:
    - a. Our after-school program continues to be going strong. We have many programs going on. Skiing has generated more than 100 participants on some days.
