Garden Coordinator Position Open at LCS

We are looking for the right person to fill the role of Garden Coordinator at LCS. The coordinator works with the Garden Committee, teachers, Food Service Director, and administration in planning each year's garden. This includes springtime tasks such as collaborating with staff in the layout of the garden, securing of seeds, compost, and other needed materials and supplies, the starting and nurturing of seedlings in the school, installation of the irrigation lines, and planting of the seedlings and other garden crops.

A critical charge for the coordinator is to involve students and teachers in the decision-making in an effort to instill a sense of ownership of the garden by the entire school.

Insofar as possible, the coordinator will work to maximize planting choices to produce food that the students and cafeteria will be able to use while school is in session.

In the summer the garden coordinator will coordinate the watering, weeding, and harvesting of crops during the summer months.

In the fall the garden coordinator will oversee the clearing of the garden, necessary preparations for winter, and the removal of the irrigation lines.

This is an opportunity for a community member to become involved in the learning process in a fun and very meaningful way. There is a stipend for this work.



One of the leading causes of everything from heart disease and cancer to substance abuse and depression, extremely stressful experiences in childhood can alter brain development and have lifelong effects on health and behavior.

But, as experts and practitioners profiled in RESILIENCE are proving, what's predictable is preventable. Physicians, educators, social workers and communities are daring to talk about the effects of abuse and neglect, domestic violence, divorce, parent in jail, and substance abusing parents.
